
My Childhood

Classroom Rules & Procedures

Students will follow these class expectations:

KALO: Kuleana (responsibility), Aloha (love and peace), Lokahi (working together in harmony), and Ohana (community/family).

- 1. BE KIND: Cooperate with everyone in the Ho'okele Elementary community including classmates, teachers, staff, guest teachers, parents, and administrators.
- BE RESPECTFUL: Respect each individual's rights, space, and their property, including the equipment and furnishings in our classroom and school.
- 3. BE RESPONSIBLE:
 - a. Follow Digital Citizenship expectations at all times
 - b. Observe the Ho'okele Elementary Handbook.
 - c. Carry out your basic student responsibilities including:
 - Keep track of your own materials and assignments.
 - Start your work on time and manage your progress.
 - Ask for help when you need it.
 - Manage your jobs responsibly while working in groups, and do your own work during independent time.
 - Turn in your assignments on time and with pride.
 - Accept responsibility for your grades and behavior.



Classroom Safety Recommendations

(from the Parent and Student Handbook)

- Indoor and outdoor masking is optional for students and employees, but highly encouraged.
- 2. Masking required for days 6-10 following a positive case or non-school related close contact.
- 3. In the event of a cluster or outbreak, masks may temporarily be required indoors.
- Indoor masking is strongly encouraged when the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) determines community levels are medium or high.
- 5. Quarantine is not required for in-school exposures, but indoor masking is strongly recommended for 10 days following an exposure.
- 6. Isolation requirements remain for anyone who test positive for COVID or has COVID-like symptoms.

Wellness Policy

We ask that you help us strive for a **peanut-free environment** for the safety of students with severe allergies. Other allergy information may be shared as necessary. Snacks or other food items brought from home are not permitted to be shared among students due to allergies or other unique dietary needs.

If providing your child with goody bags for personal celebrations, we HIGHLY ENCOURAGE **non-food items** or individually wrapped and labeled snacks that meet our wellness guidelines. These items will be distributed at the end of the school day for students to take home.
